

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SALMO

BY-LAW NO. 358

A by-law to stop up and close to vehicular traffic only a portion of road.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Salmo deems it necessary to stop up and close that portion of road connecting Highway 6 to Hutcheson Avenue at Fourth Street as shown on the plan attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this by-law;

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Salmo deems it necessary to relocate the crossing to connect Highway 6 to Hutcheson Avenue at Second Street;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Salmo, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:-

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Village of Salmo Road Closing By-law No. 358, 1990".
2. That portion of road connecting Highway 6 to Hutcheson Avenue known as the Fourth Street Railway Crossing, is hereby stopped up and closed to vehicular traffic only.
3. That the railway crossing be relocated to connect Highway 6 and Hutcheson Avenue at Second Street.
4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of its registration in the office of the Inspector of Municipalities.


