

A by-law to improve and upgrade streets and alleys.

The Council of the Village of Salmo in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:-

1. Where an application to subdivide property has been made and access roads are required, such roads will be installed on the following conditions:

- (a) In the case of a new subdivision or a new area, it shall be the responsibility of the applicant or the developer, (these two terms are synonymous for the purposes of this by-law) to provide at his entire expense:
 - (i) all roadbeds within the subdivision or area;
 - (ii) the necessary roadbed or improvement of an existing street from a travelled street to the subdivision or the property where the roadbed is required.
- (b) Every roadbed installation and all work carried out under this by-law shall be of a standard satisfactory to the Municipal Engineer or Superintendent and shall be under the supervision of the said Engineer or Superintendent, and the developer shall advise the Council in writing before the installation of a roadbed is commenced.
- (c) The Village of Salmo shall not be required to contribute to any roadbed installation constructed pursuant to this by-law.

2. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Salmo Improvement and Upgrading of Streets and Alleys By-law No. 267, 1982".
