

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SALMO

BY-LAW NO. 298

A by-law of the Village of Salmo to prohibit the discharge of firearms within the Village of Salmo.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the best interests of the citizens of the Village of Salmo and the General Public that the firing of firearms be prohibited within the Village;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Salmo, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS
"Firearms"

means any barrellled weapon from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged and that is capable of causing serious bodily injury or death to a person, and includes any frame or receiver of such a barrellled weapon and anything that can be adapted for use as a firearm and also includes antique firearms.

"Antique Firearm"

means any firearm manufactured before 1898 that was not designed to use rimfire or centre-fire ammunition and that has not been redesigned to use such ammunition or, if so designed or redesigned, is capable only of using rimfire or centre-fire ammunition that is no longer commercially manufactured.

2. No firearm shall be discharged within the boundaries of the Village of Salmo.

3. The provisions of this by-law do not apply to a Peace Officer or Police Officer as defined by the Criminal Code of Canada.

4. Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of this by-law shall, upon summary conviction, be liable to a fine not exceeding FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00), together with costs of conviction.


5. This by-law shall take effect from the date of registration in the Office of the Inspector of Municipalities.



6. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Salmo Prohibition of Firearms By-law No. 298, 1986".


