

Inter-Community Business Licence (ICBL)

You may be eligible for an upgrade that allows you to do business in 10 communities across the Kootenays under one license.

YOU COULD SAVE OVER \$300 IF YOU WORK IN MULTIPLE COMMUNITIES!

The Village of Salmo is participating in the West Kootenay Inter-Community Business License Program, which covers 10 municipalities. The ICBL allows mobile businesses to operate in multiple municipalities, under one license, rather than obtaining non-residence licenses from each municipality.

The ICBL is valid for the same term as your regular Business License. Requests for this endorsement can be made at the Village Office at 423 Davies Avenue or call (250) 357-9433.

WHERE IS THE ICBL VALID?

The Kootenay ICBL is valid in the following municipalities: City of Castlegar, Town of Creston, City of Grand Forks, Village of Kaslo, City of Nelson, Village of New Denver, City of Rossland, Village of Salmo, Village of Silverton, Village of Slocan

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES?

For Businesses: Reduced time and cost and simplified expansion into new communities. For

For Residents: There will be more choice of contractors and service providers.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The ICBL program is open to all businesses that perform mobile type services in one or more of the ten (10) participating Kootenay municipalities. In general, this would include businesses that move from client-to-client, as opposed to clients coming to them, eg. trades, plumbers, electricians, etc.

WHAT IS THE COST OF AN ICBL?

An eligible mobile business (including homebased businesses) pays the Village of Salmo Business License fee (which varies depending on business type), plus the annual ICBL fee of \$100.

This endorsement can save hundreds of dollars in Business License fees.
