Policy Statement:

It is the policy of Council to encourage trees on boulevards.

Policy Background:

Trees located on boulevards are appreciated by the community generally, but occasionally some trees are deemed to be a nuisance due to interference with overhead wires, root penetration in sewer lines, and similar problems. Dead trees are deemed to be a hazard to persons and property.

Policy Goal:

It is the goal of this policy to establish guidelines for the sponsorship, planting, pruning, and removal of trees.

Policy Objectives:

The Civic Works Foreman shall be authorized to remove a tree situated on a public boulevard for the following reasons:

- the tree is dead;
- the tree is diseased;
- the tree interferes with public service infrastructure, or
- the trees impedes access to property being developed.

To restrict trees planted on boulevards to those listed on Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this Policy.

To restrict large shrubs on boulevards to those listed on Schedule "B" attached to and forming part of this Policy.
