# THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SALMO BYLAW #601

#### A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE A LOAN TO PURCHASE A PUBLIC WORKS TRUCK

WHEREAS section 179 of the *Community Charter* (SBC Chapter 26) authorizes Council to incur a liability by borrowing for a capital purpose, and

WHEREAS Council deems it desirable and expedient to purchase a new multi-purpose public works truck, and

WHEREAS the estimated cost of the vehicle exceeds available funds in the current budget and requires a capital borrowing of \$100,000, which is the amount of debt created by this bylaw,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Salmo, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

## SHORT TITLE

1. (1) This Bylaw may be cited as the **"Public Works Truck Loan Authorization Bylaw"** 

## LOAN AUTHORIZATION

- 2. (1) The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to purchase a new 5-ton dieselpowered multi-use truck for public works purposes.
  - (2) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
- 3. (1) The maximum term for which debentures may be issued to secure the debt created by this bylaw is 5 (five) years.

#### ENACTMENT

- 4. (1) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid portion shall be severed and the part that is invalid shall not affect the validity of the remainder.
  - (2) This Bylaw shall come into full force and effect on final adoption.
