2.0 Tender Documents

2.1 The tender documents which a tenderer should review to prepare a tender consist of all of the *Contract Documents* listed in Schedule 1 entitled “Schedule of Contract Documents”. All sections of this publication are by reference included in the *Contract Documents*.

2.3 Any additional information made available to tenderers prior to the *Tender Closing Time* by the *Owner* or representative of the *Owner*, such as geotechnical reports or as-built plans, which is not expressly included in Schedule 1 or Schedule 2 to the Agreement, is not included in the *Contract Documents*. Such additional information is made available only for the assistance of tenderers who must make their own judgment about its reliability, accuracy, completeness and relevance to the *Contract*, and neither the *Owner* nor any representative of the *Owner* gives any guarantee or representation that the additional information is reliable, accurate, complete or relevant.

In no event will the Owner be required to offer any modified terms to any other Tenderer prior to entering into a contract with the successful Tenderer and the Owner shall incur no liability to any other Tenderer as a result of such negotiations or modifications

1.3 Time shall be of the essence of the *Contract*.

Article 2 Contract Documents

2.1 The "Contract Documents" consist of the documents listed or referred to in Schedule 1, entitled "Schedule of Contract Documents", which is attached and forms a part of this Agreement, and includes any and all additional and amending documents issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of the Contract Documents shall constitute the entire *Contract* between the *Owner* and the *Contractor*.

2.2 The *Contract* supersedes all prior negotiations, representations or agreements, whether written or oral, and the *Contract* may be amended only in strict accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents.

Article 3 Contract Price

3.1 The price for the *Work* ("Contract Price") shall be the sum in Canadian dollars of the following

1.1.1 the product of the actual quantities of the items of *Work* listed in the Schedule of Quantities and Prices which are incorporated into or made necessary by the *Work* and the unit prices listed in the Schedule of Quantities and Prices; plus

1.1.2 all lump sums, if any, as listed in the Schedule of Quantities and Prices, for items relating to or incorporated into the *Work*; plus

1.1.3 any adjustments, including any payments owing on account of *Changes* and agreed to *Extra Work*, approved in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents.

3.2 The Contract Price shall be the entire compensation owing to the *Contractor* for the *Work* and this compensation shall cover and include all profit and all costs of supervision, labour, material, equipment, overhead, financing, and all other costs and expenses whatsoever incurred in performing the *Work*.

Article 4 Payment

4.1 Subject to applicable legislation and the provisions of the Contract Documents, the *Owner* shall make payments to the *Contractor*.

4.2 If the *Owner* fails to make payments to the *Contractor* as they become due in accordance with the terms of the Contract Documents then interest calculated at 2% per annum over the prime commercial lending rate of the Royal Bank of Canada on such unpaid amounts shall also become due and payable until payment. Such interest shall be calculated and added to any unpaid

amounts monthly.

Article 5 Rights and Remedies

- 5.1 The duties and obligations imposed by the Contract Documents and the rights and remedies available thereunder shall be in addition to and not a limitation of any duties, obligations, rights and remedies otherwise imposed or available by law.
- 5.2 Except as specifically set out in the Contract Documents, no action or failure to act by the *Owner*, Contract Administrator or *Contractor* shall constitute a waiver of any of the parties' rights or duties afforded under the *Contract*, nor shall any such action or failure to act constitute an approval of or acquiescence in any breach under the *Contract*.

Article 6 Notices

- 6.1 Communications among the *Owner*, the Contract Administrator and the *Contractor*, including all written notices required by the Contract Documents, may be delivered by hand, or by fax, or by pre-paid registered mail to the addresses as set out below:

- 6.3 The *Owner* or the *Contractor* may, at any time, change its address for notice by giving written notice to the other at the address then applicable. - 6.4 The sender of a notice by fax assumes all risk that the fax is received in hard copy.

Article 7 General

- 7.1 This *Contract* shall be construed according to the laws of British Columbia.
- 7.2 The *Contractor* shall not, without the express written consent of the *Owner*, assign this *Contract*, or any portion of this *Contract*.
- 7.3 The headings included in the *Contract Documents* are for convenience only and do not form part of this *Contract* and will not be used to interpret, define or limit the scope or intent of this *Contract* or any of the provisions of the *Contract Documents*.
- 7.4 A word in the *Contract Documents* in the singular includes the plural and, in each case, vice versa.
- 7.5 This agreement shall ensure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties and their successors, executors, administrators and assigns.

- 4.1.1 the appendices as required by paragraph 5.3 of the Instructions to Tenderers – Part II; and
- 4.1.2 the *Bid Security* as required by paragraph 5.2 of the Instructions to Tenderers – Part II.
- WE AGREE:** 5.1 that this tender will be irrevocable and open for acceptance by the *Owner* for a period of 30 calendar days from the day following the *Tender Closing Date and Time*, even if the tender of another tenderer is accepted by the *Owner*. If within this period the *Owner* delivers a written notice ("*Notice of Award*") by which the *Owner* accepts our tender we will:

- .3 a "clearance letter" indicating that the tenderer is in Worksafe BC compliance; and
- .4 a copy of the insurance policies as specified in GC 24 indicating that all such insurance coverage is in place and;

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SGC 1000 – SUPPLEMENTARY GENERAL CONDITIONS

The General Conditions of the Master Municipal Construction Documents, Platinum Edition Volume II 2019, shall govern the execution of the contract except as amended herein.

SGC 1 GENERAL

.1 Construction Hours

Construction shall be limited to between 7am to 5pm, Monday through Fridays, and carried out in compliance with Village of Salmo Anti-Noise Bylaw No. 216. Construction on weekends is prohibited without written acceptance from the Contract Administrator.

.2 Glendale Bridge Traffic

During all working hours, Glendale Bridge shall remain open to, at minimum, single-lane, alternating traffic suitably signed and supervised by a qualified contractor and in accordance with the Contractor-provided Traffic Management Plan. Outside of working hours, overnight and weekends, Glendale Bridge shall remain open to two-direction traffic. The Contractor shall be responsible for site construction safety, regardless of hours, from mobilization through to construction completion and demobilization.

1.4 – Traffic Control

Add:

SS 1.4.14 Traffic Management and TMP

The Contractor will be responsible for traffic management and preparation of a Traffic Management Plan (TMP) in accordance with MoTT 2020 Traffic Management Manual for Work on Roadways. The TMP shall be prepared by a qualified traffic management contractor and submitted to the Contract Administrator for review and acceptance a within **(21) calendar days** from Notice of Proceed.

During all working hours, Glendale Bridge shall remain open to, at minimum, single-lane, alternating traffic suitably signed and supervised by a qualified contractor and in accordance with the TMP. Outside of working hours, overnight and weekends, Glendale Bridge shall remain open to two-direction traffic. The Contractor shall be responsible for site construction safety, regardless of hours, from mobilization through to construction completion and demobilization.

Delete paragraph 1.5 and replace with:

SS-1.5 Payment

Payment for all work paid under this section will be made per Item 2 of Appendix 1 – Schedule of Quantities and Prices and shall be paid progressively with project completion percentages and with no draw of greater than 50%, with the exception of final project invoice. Item 2 will only be paid in full once the project has achieved substantial completion.

Section SS 1000.1 - Other

SS 2 Mobilization, Demobilization, Bonding & Insurance

.1 - Payment

Item 1 will be paid progressively with project completion percentages and with no draw of greater than 50%, with the exception of final project invoice. Item 1 will only be paid in full once the project has achieved substantial completion.

SS 3 Shop Drawing Preparation

.1 - Execution

Item 3 shall include preparation of shop drawings of all fabricated components, including dimensions and tolerances, and submission of the completed shop drawing package to the Contract Administrator for review and acceptance within **(21) calendar days** from the Notice to Proceed.

.2 - Payment

Item 3 will be measured on a lump sum basis paid progressively with project completion. Item 1 will only be paid in full once the shop drawings have been reviewed and approved by the Contract Administrator.

SS 4 Fabrication of Steel Components

.1 - Execution

Item 4 shall include all work, equipment and materials to fabricate all steel components, to the specifications indicated on the Contract Drawings, required to complete the project per the Contract Documents, including delivery and offloading at the project site.

.2 – Payment

Item 4 will be measured on a lump sum basis paid progressively with project completion percentages and with no draw of greater than 50%, with the exception of final project invoice. Item 1 will only be paid in full once the new fabricated guardrails have been delivered to site.

SS 5 Removal and Disposal of Existing Guardrails

.1 – Execution

Item 5 shall include all work, equipment and materials to remove the existing guardrails and dispose of all materials at an approved waste handling facility.

.2 – Payment

Item 5 will be measured on a lump sum basis and paid progressively with project completion percentages and will only be paid in full once the project has achieved substantial completion.

SS 6 Installation of New Guardrails

.1 – Execution

Item 6 shall include all work, equipment and materials to install the new guardrails and all components per the design and specifications indicated on the Contract Drawings and in accordance with the Traffic Management Plan.

.2 – Payment

Item 6 will be measured on a lump sum basis and paid progressively with project completion percentages and will only be paid in full once the project has achieved substantial completion.
